#### **Sharing The Bread and Cup**

The communion table at Gower is open to everyone without a single exception. You are invited to come forward to the rail through the centre aisles, guided by the ushers, to receive a communion wafer and a glass of grape juice. There is also a station where you can receive a communion wafer and a glass of grape juice on the balcony. Please let the server know if you require a gluten-free option, and they will provide one. Once you have received the elements, you are welcome to eat and return your seat as you are ready.



If you do not wish to receive communion, you are welcome to either remain seated or come forward with your arms crossed to receive a blessing. If you are unable to come forward, we will come to serve you in your seat following serving the rail.
